

Graeme Black

After graduating in fashion from Edinburgh University in 1998, Graeme Black began his career as an Assistant Designer working in London for, among others, John Galiano and Zandra Rhodes. Moving to Italy in 1993 he worked as a Designer for Les Copains and moved through the ranks at Giorgio Armani to become Head Designer at Borgonuovo Black Label. In 2003, he became the Head of Womenswear for Ferragamo. 2005 saw the launch of the first Graeme Black collection and in September 2007 Graeme left Ferragamo to concentrate on his own line.

Graeme Black presented his first runway collection under his own name at London Fashion Week February 2008, to critical acclaim.
